Subject: Non-applicability of CE marking to the Structured Water Products "Under the Sink" and "Whole House"

Dear Mr. Butts,

With this letter Alura Group, confirms that on the request of Natural Action Technologies Inc. we conducted an investigation on the applicability of the European New Approach Directives and the CE marking to the Structured Water Products "Under the Sink" and "Whole House".

We can confirm that this product currently does not fall within the scope of any of the European 'New Approach Directives', which would require the product to be CE marked before placing on the market, or putting into service, in the European Economic Area.

Also not applicable is the Construction Products Regulation 305/2011. This regulation only applies when there is a European harmonised standard or technical specification, and currently, for these products these do not exist.

This means that the CE marking is not a requirement for the Structured Water Products "Under the Sink" and "Whole House" to be allowed to be sold or used in the European Economic Area. According to the European rules it would be even unlawful to affix the CE marking.
